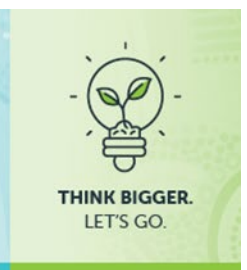
Key Responsibilities and Outcomes
