About The Role:

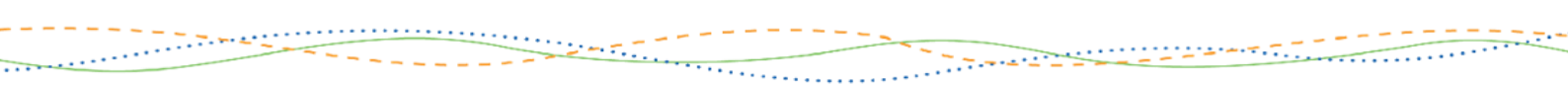
Whitsunday Regional Council is seeking a skilled and safety-focused **Plant Operator** to join our Quarry team.

- Operating a range of quarry mobile plant and fixed crushing plant equipment.

 - Operating equipment such as front-end loaders, excavators and articulated dump trucks as required.
