Position Purpose

This position will work across the region as a part of the Assets and Systems team, carrying out tasks as directed by an Assets and Systems leader, in a conscientious and efficient manner in order to deliver on Council's broader inspection needs.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

As a Labourer Operations – Network Inspection and a member of the Civil Services Department you will:

- Provide operational and field-based support for civil infrastructure inspection activities, assisting with site preparation, access and inspection readiness.
- Support inspection officers by operating diagnostic and inspection equipment to identify faults and defects, and to carry out testing and verification of asset components.
- Collect, handle, and record inspection-related information and observations, providing accurate input into technical data from inspections and maintenance activities in line with team systems and processes.
- Support inspection staff by assisting with setup, transportation and pack-down of tools, equipment and materials to enable efficient service delivery.
- Assist the Assets and Systems team with day-to-day operational and service support tasks, in accordance with established procedures and priorities.
- Build solid working relationships with a range of broad work teams and their employees to ensure delivery of all works is done in a professional manner.
- Identify where the safe disposal of materials and waste is required and undertake the disposal process in a safe and effective manner.
- Correctly use and maintain plant and equipment provided, including all personal protective equipment, in accordance with manufacturer's instructions, council's safety policy and procedures
