Position Purpose

This position operates a suite of machinery, supporting the needs of the broader City of Moreton Bay Council (Council) customers, ratepayers and stakeholders.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

As a Waste Management Facility Operator and member of the Waste & Resource Recovery team you will:

- Undertake the full day to day operation of a range of heavy/medium/light plant in order to deliver quality waste management services and drive optimal waste facility service standards.
- Undertake the identification of issues that may impact on the environment and safety of the work site and escalate accordingly in order to manage possible risks.
- Undertake a suite of day to day operations at the waste management facilities in accordance with the Environmental Approval Conditions, Site Based Management Plans, Landfill Operator Guides and Manuals, and the Workplace Health and Safety Act and Regulations.
- Support the wider outputs of the Waste Services department and work as an integral part in supporting team outputs in the day to day operations across a range of elements relevant to landfill operations and to other waste facility operations.
- Correctly use and maintain plant and equipment provided, including all personal protective equipment, in accordance with manufacturer's instructions, Council's safety policy and procedures.
- Undertake the end to end suite of administration processes, practice and procedures as required within the deliverables of this position.
