- Be required to undertake a Pre-Employment Medical;
- Applicants may be required to undertake pre-employment literacy and numeracy tests;
- Have the ability to work independently and in a team environment to work towards and achieve team objectives; and
- The ability to multi-task while maintaining high attention to detail.
