- Monitor works to ensure they meet plans, specifications, quality, time and cost requirements.

- Operate road, bridge and drainage plant, equipment and tools safely when required.
- Ensure WHS, traffic control, environmental and risk management requirements are followed.
- Communicate with staff, contractors, engineers and other stakeholders.
- Provide coaching, mentoring and support to team members.
- Complete WHS audits and assist with incident investigations and corrective actions.
- Contribute to continuous improvement and demonstrate Council's values.
